U-Bahn (underground): U4, U5 or U3, U6 "Odeonsplatz"

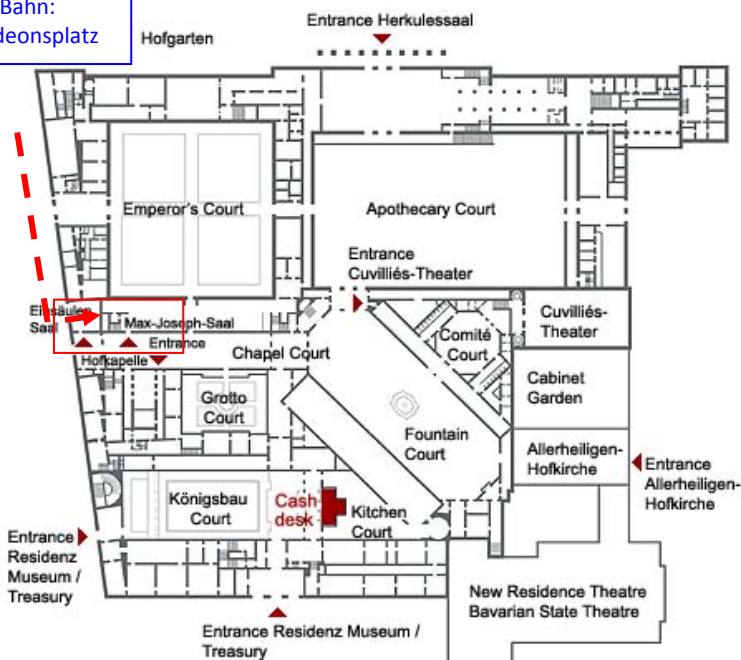
