Smart Villages: Apply of SV approach to improve the framework for innovation through new forms of stakeholder involvement facilitated by ICT. Lead of **ASP project** whose objective is to support the sustainable and community-centered development and the digital transformation of mountain and rural areas (6 countries, 9 regions involved, 13 partners and 12 test areas). Open data & Big data: launch of the new thematic area on trending topic about data gathering and usage in the current *digital age* pursuing an **European Strategy for Data** as a common European data spaces tailored on the Alpine priorities. Creation of a **focus group** on these topics to bring forward a common vision for the Alpine area.

Digital Infrastructures: Publication of the **feasibility study** on cross-border connectivity in the Alpine region, identifying models of intervention, 14 cross border gaps and 4 possible applications to develop infrastructure of cross border fiber optic backbones to **fulfill the connectivity gaps in the Alpine Area**.
