Field(s) of activity of respondents' organizations

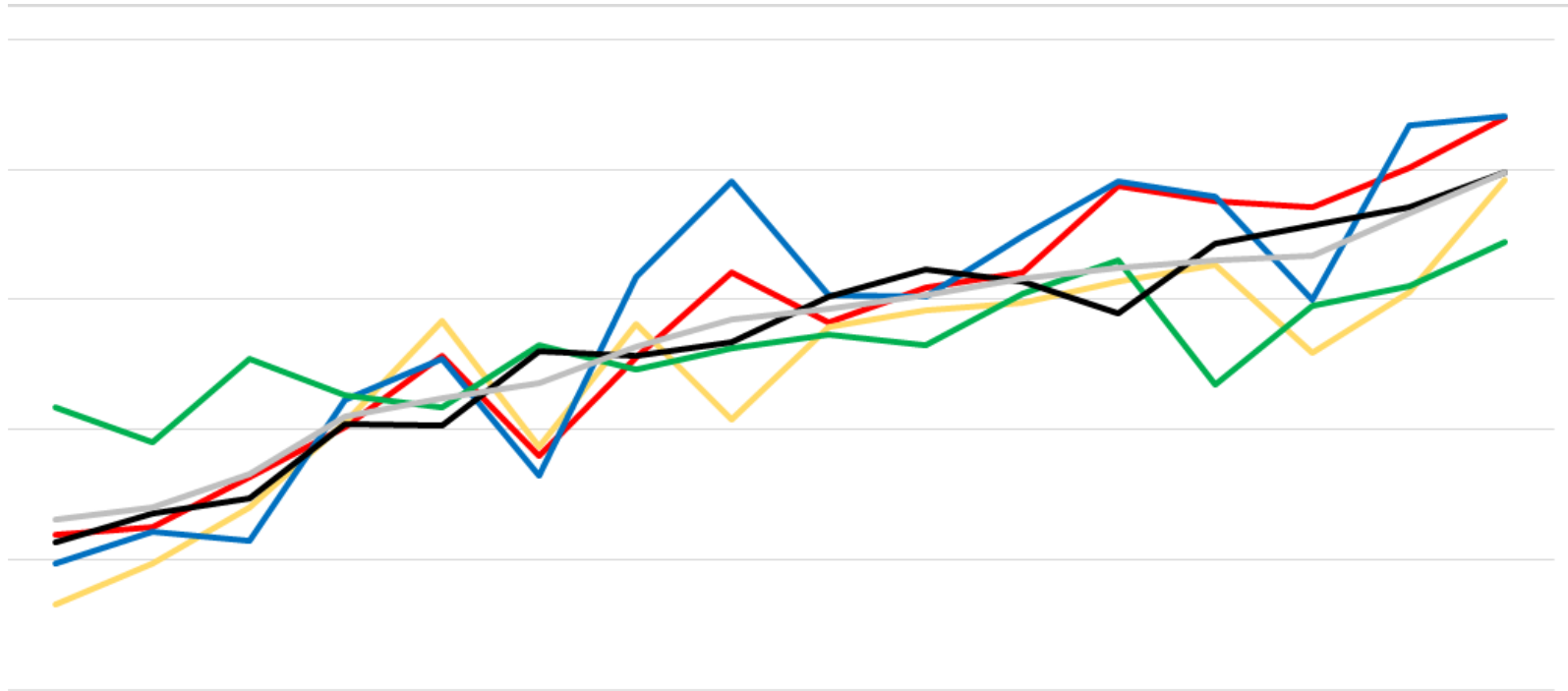


Goals of the survey
